Dry Gulch upgrade

A major bridge rehabilitation project on the Coquihalla Highway will begin this spring, the first major work on the Dry Gulch Bridge since it was built in 1985. It will extend the life of this steel-arch bridge well into the future.

All four lanes of the bridge deck will be resurfaced, and the abutment bearings and expansion joints will be replaced.

The project is now tendered on BC Bid. Close to 20 direct jobs are expected to be created, and the work should be completed by Fall.

TMX info session

At Wednesday evening's public info session, more than 15 Kinder Morgan managers attended, to outline the project construction plans and schedules, potential community impacts & mitigations, and job & supply opportunities.

The company is moving forward with the planning required to begin construction in the BC Interior in September 2017. Initially, there will be small crews working on right of way clearing, preparation of temporary work spaces and starting on critical trenchless river crossings.

Merritt will be a home-base in 'Section 5A' which extends from Black Pines in the North Thompson to the Coquihalla summit. There will be 550 workers + 60 construction management staff residing in Merritt at the peak of the workforce in Fall 2018 through Spring 2019. As well as local accommodations — hotels, RV parks & rental properties — to house workers, TM will build a sleeper camp to accommodate 350 of the workers.

The bulk of the jobs will be labourers, but they'll also need an array of trades: welders, equipment operators, etc. Anyone interested in applying must do so online at www.transmountain.com.
