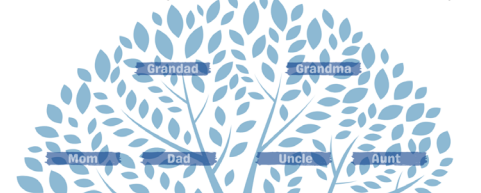

The Merritt RCMP wish to thank the community for their vigilance and patience while officers carried out the search, says RCMP spokesperson Cpl. James Grandy.

The investigation is ongoing.

Foreclosure proceedings for Olympic Villas

The Olympic Villas affordable housing project at 4010 Walters St., was completed in Nov 2022 with \$16.6M in low-interest financing from BC Housing.

Foreclosure proceedings were initiated by BC Housing against Olympic Villas Inc. and TBS Procurement Interface Inc. last November. In its petition to the court, which was later amended in Jan 2024, BC Housing said that it was owed \$17,089,152.67 as of Sept. 30, 2023, with interest. The mortgage was registered in March 2020 and saw BC Housing provide \$16,595,028 in interim construction financing.

A multitude of troubles — including a jump in interest rates from the low-interest rate of funding through BC Housing's HousingHub program; a 19.8% project overrun amounting to \$23,615,000; extended repayment deadlines, to May 2021, then Jan 2022, then Aug 2022, the final repayment date Nov 2022; and construction delays from Covid & supply chain disruptions — have conspired to complicate the situation. On top of that, an error in not signing a modified agreement, BC Housing filing the modified mortgage title Sept 2023, and the serving of a notice of default to the borrowers for being in arrears on property taxes for 2022 and 2023 — and BC Housing finally initiated foreclosure proceedings last November.

More recently, Olympic Villas Inc. and TBS Procurement Interface Inc. have tried to convert the foreclosure proceedings into a civil action, but that was denied and the Supreme Court of British Columbia granted BC Housing an order nisi last month, confirming the outstanding debt at \$18,040,130.72 as of April 11, 2024, with interest now accruing at \$3,558.60 per day. If the outstanding debt is not paid by Nov 20th, BC Housing can apply for conduct of sale, which would allow it to sell the property to recover the debt.

Olympic Villas has been investigating the possibility of refinancing the property with the Canadian Mortgage and Housing Corporation — though CMHC requires the project to be 97% tenanted (currently they are 84% tenanted, with 63 of its 75 units leased). They say they have now hired a marketing agency to boost the number of tenants, and retained Colliers to assist them in soliciting offers for the property.

The borrowers say they are confident they will be able to secure either a sale or refinancing by no later than November 2024 and pay the outstanding debt off in full.
